Women's health

Clinicians

- Needlestick and muscular skeletal injury caused by poor visibility and ergonomic posture
- Increased stress caused by pressure to repair on top of caring for mother and baby and inability to employ best practice



Maternal departments

- Financial burden of lawsuits, referrals, surgery, occupational health and staff cover costs
- The need for a second staff member pulls frontline staff away from other patients
